It's not included in regular cholesterol tests or lipid panels. While diet and exercise don't lower Lp(a) levels, they do improve overall heart health. If someone in your family has high Lp(a), close relatives should get tested too!

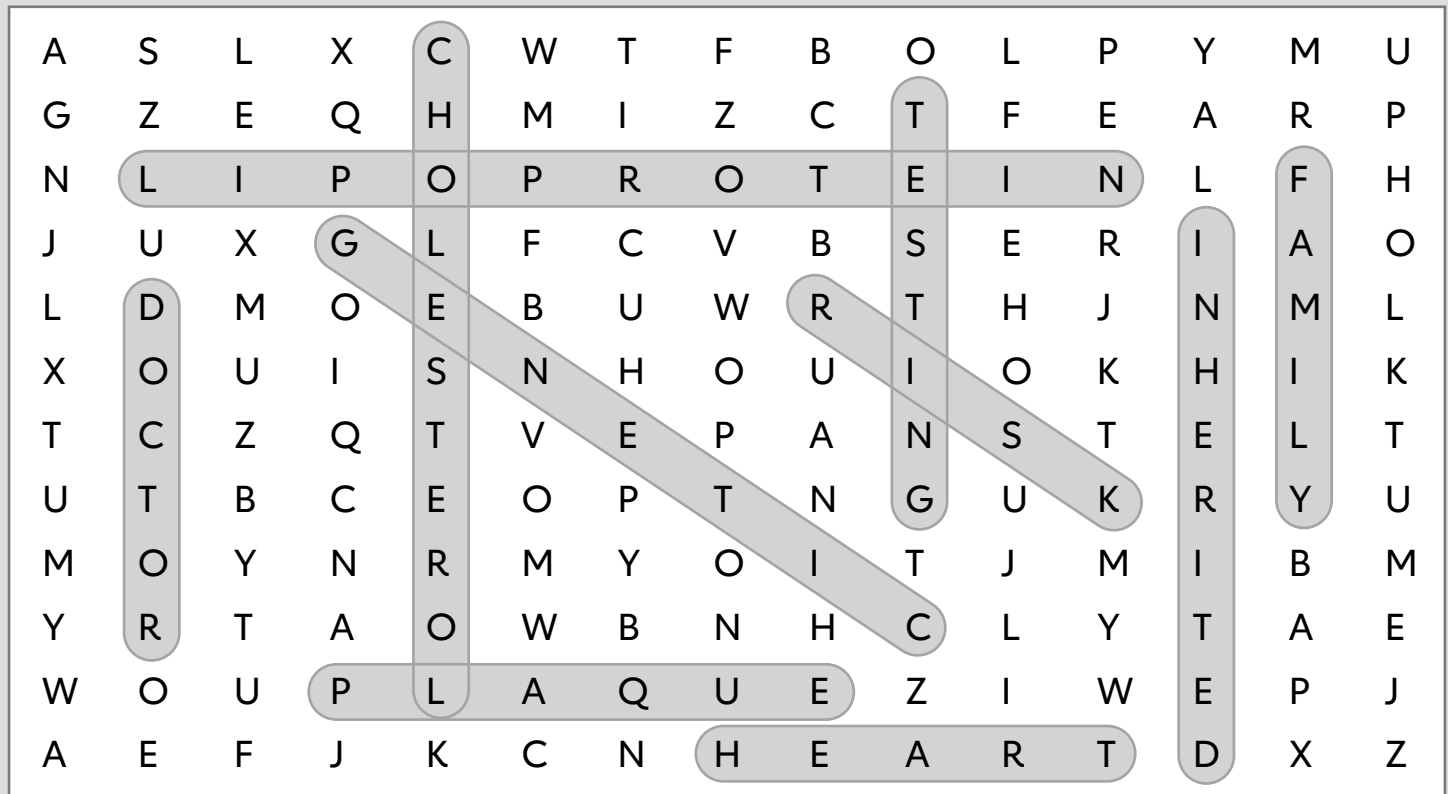
